## Conditions of Booking

### Payment

To secure a training place it is necessary for you to send us your completed form and payment. Provisional bookings are not secure until payment has cleared.

### Cancellation

Cancellation or Postponement of the booking must be in writing and will result in the loss of the course fee unless we are able to fill the place or places. In this instance an admin fee of 10% will be levied. Watercraft reserves the right to cancel courses for operational reasons. In this event all payments will be refunded in full if alternative dates cannot be agreed. Watercraft can accept no responsibility for the effect that weather conditions may have upon any of the training offered. Severe weather conditions may cause Watercraft to cancel or postpone water based training for reasons of safety.

### Safety

For all water based training, please make sure that you advise the instructor if you or any other candidate are unable to swim. Any candidate who, in the opinion of the instructor is unfit or unsafe to take part in an activity or is behaving in a way likely to endanger themselves or others, may be excluded from further participation in the activity.

### Lost Property

Any items of property left by candidates will be retained for a period of 3 months for the candidate to collect.

### Insurance

Our craft, equipment, and instructors are covered by a Public Liability Insurance Policy. Watercraft and its staff will at all times take every reasonable precaution to ensure the comfort and safety of the candidate, and therefore the school shall not be held liable for death, personal injury, accident, sickness, loss or damage to the students property or person.
